I. Information/Discussion Items

a. Dining Pricing Discussion

- i. Kevin noted that the price of food has gone up due to weather conditions and they have no control over it. He did note that he would be making only a few price proposals. The committee looked at the spreadsheet of prices from the past few years that Rick provided and noted any prices that should be lowered or for sure not be raised. It was noted that prices at Freshen's could not be regulated by the committee. Tim asked about the difference in quality/price of the dollar menu and the regular menu at the club because regular menu items are often sitting out under the heating lamp while the dollar menu items are freshly made. Kevin said that the regular menu items are pre-made during lunch rushes and that customers can order fresh items whenever they would like.**

- i. The committee agreed that there should be no breakfast in the club on the weekends and that the Sunday brunch is sufficient. Members also felt that the Coffee House and the Union should first open later on the weekends and open early depending on events. Kevin did mention that the Coffee House is popular during the weekends but not early in the morning.**
