

# Mental Health Technician (CSP) Training and Orientation Plan

## **DHS 63.06(6): Orientation and Training Requirements:**

Each CSP shall develop and implement an orientation and training program which all new staff and regularly scheduled volunteers shall complete. The orientation shall include:

1. Review of the applicable parts of DHS 63
2. Review of CSP policies
3. Review of the job responsibilities specified in the job description
4. Review of ch. DHS 94, patient rights
5. Review of ch. DHS 92, confidentiality of treatment records

## **ForwardHealth Mental Health Technician Training and Education Certification Requirements**

For BadgerCare Plus and Wisconsin Medicaid reimbursement, a mental health technician must meet the following training and education requirements:

1. Completion of a minimum of 1,000 hours of supervised work experience with long-term mentally ill individuals.
2. At least one of the following:
  - Approval from the DQA of an educational curriculum for the mental health technician. The agency must then provide or purchase the training.
  - Certification by the American Occupational Therapy Association as an occupational therapy assistant.
  - A licensed practical nurse under s. [441.10](#), Wis. Stats.
  - Completion of the training requirements under [DHS 133.17\(4\)](#), Wis. Admin. Code for a home health aide.
  - Inclusion in the registry of persons under [DHS 129.10](#), Wis. Admin. Code, who have completed a nurse's assistant training and testing program or only a testing program.
  - Satisfaction of the requirements under [DHS 105.17\(3\)\(a\)1.](#), Wis. Admin. Code, to provide personal care services and completion of an additional 1,000 hours of supervised work experience with long-term mentally ill persons [persons with severe and persistent mental illness].
3. A mental health technician providing CSP services who does not meet the requirements above must meet these requirements within one year following the effective date of the CSP's Medicaid enrollment or the mental health technician's date of employment by the CSP, whichever is later. If this requirement is not met, the CSP may no longer submit claims to ForwardHealth for the mental health technician's services. However, the CSP may submit claims to ForwardHealth for the mental health technician's services during the one year period.
